AMAAD was incorporated through a peer-based framework, and over the years has harnessed its collective human and material resources to serve multifaceted communities through transitional housing, Behavioral Health programming, and advocacy, while utilizing an approach that is especially relevant to those whom are disproportionately affected.

AMAAD is seeking a dynamic individual to serve as a Prevention Specialist. The Prevention Specialist works collaboratively with the Youth Health and Wellness Manager to provide HIV prevention and linkage activities to ensure prevention services are accessible and inclusive to the communities that need it most. These activities will include 1) targeted testing/counseling & linkage to care; 2) Condom Distribution; 3) Prevention with Positives; 4) Community Education; 5) PrEP Navigation; and 6) Active referrals. The successful candidate will have a strong knowledge of the best practices in observation and listening, communication, patience, empathy, and facilitating evidence-based curricula and identifying additional needs of participants through screening and assessments.

Like all AMAAD employees, the Prevention Specialist should demonstrate a strong commitment to the mission and values of AMAAD and should have substantial expertise in all areas of responsibility. KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Support Services and Relationship Management

- Provide confidential assessment to determine HIV prevention needs of participants, regardless of whether test results are positive or negative; this includes the planning and referral of prevention service;
- Provide HIV testing and STD screening on-site and through outreach into the community, including local bars/clubs and other community settings where the target population socializes and/or congregates as needed;
- Conducting community-based outreach in order to recruit priority populations into HIV/STI testing & prevention services through various in-person and social media/app-based activities;
- Facilitating the distribution of condoms and safer sex supplies to locations frequented by priority populations, including identifying new sites and manage and maintain all safer sex material inventory for Prevention Team;
- Assess participant needs and link participants to effective prevention and essential support services including
 housing, nutrition assistance, mental health and substance abuse treatment, employment services, and other needs
 as identified by participants.

Operational

- Clearly and accurately Complete required documentation for HIV Prevention programs including HIV Counseling and Testing Forms and consents, participant satisfactory surveys, Program screeners, sign-in sheets, incentive logs, program forms et cetera;
- Collaborate with project and organizational staff in advertising and media promotion of the HIV testing and PrEP program, including the use of geo-social networking and platforms;
- Collect and report data on program activities;
- Stay informed about current HIV/AIDS trends, prevention and care efforts and strategies.
- All other duties as assigned.

- High school diploma required; Bachelor's degree, welcomed, or the combination of education, training and experience commensurate with others in this position;
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- Valid Certified HIV Counseling and Testing Certification and/or ability to pass certification within two
 months of hire date:
- Functional and technical knowledge and skills required to perform well; uses best practices and demonstrates upto-date knowledge and skills in technology.

COMMITMENT:

 Monday through Friday, approximately 9:00AM – 5:00PM (occasionally later with some weekends depending on programming)

COMPENSATION:

- (\$25 hr.) commensurate with experience and internal equity. All employees are eligible for annual performance-based salary increases. Because we value staff tenure in each role, we do not currently cap salary ranges.
