The successful candidate will have a strong knowledge of the best practices in strengthening communities by providing direct prevention and intervention services through a Community Based Participatory Research (CBPR) framework to individuals and families intended to enhance one's quality of life.

- Co-create from start a polished and professional podcast episodes to help us spread our message;
- Develop marking plans to measure the effectivity of the strategies that are intended to raise;
- Develop innovative strategies to engage the audience, build up fan communities across platforms and raise awareness of the podcast channel;
- Ensure that the podcast is running smoothly and effectively;
- Support the development and production of live podcasts
